## Social Events

- Hall used for community events not all want to go to Centre 81
- 2. Bring back parish dances
- 3. Have a meeting like this every month
- 4. Parish barbecue
- 5. 'Open mike' night
- 6. Organise more parish fundraising especially family events
- 7. Yearly church barbecue with events
- More events, more social events but more people need to be involved, somehow more people need to get involved
- 9. Parish dances
- 10. Family nights
- 11. Summer fete
- 12. Parish dances
- 13. Parish fete in parish grounds
- 14. Get together monthly for older people
- 15. More community events
- 16. FUN in the parish i.e. bus runs, parish dances, etc.

# For Young People

- Ways to encourage teenagers to attend mass and take part in groups through the parish
- 18. More active older youth group
- 19. Older youth club
- 20. Encourage children at youth groups to tell how good it is to be part of, maybe help to bring more youth to church
- 21. An opportunity where the youth can ask openly about the church, faith and all other aspects of our religion – hopefully where they can be more open and honest in their questioning to allow a deeper understanding, allow them to challenge
- 22. The youth clubs continue
- 23. Encourage the young people of the parish back to mass
- 24. Re-start discussion group to talk about difficult questions and develop faith – particularly aimed at teenagers and young adults, priests could go into secondary

schools to give a taster session during RE

- 25. Build on youth events and involvement
- 26. Younger people involved in liturgy
- 27. Try to get some younger parishioners involved in readings, music groups, etc.
- 28. More engagement with schools to enhance religious awareness and learning at an earlier age, not necessarily by the clergy but perhaps with / by pastoral team and not only at preparation of sacraments

## Communication

- 29. Introduce a parish newsletter to be put through the doors of parishioners letting them know what is going on in the parish – twice a year
- 30. Welcome to new members
- 31. Keep the parish community informed of all the different things that are on going
- 32. Display and promote awareness at areas people visit i.e. health centre, Post Office, shops, etc.
- 33. Why are parishioners not told of weekly income of church collections and how it is implemented?
- 34. Informed regarding repairs to church, hall, road, etc. and maybe more would be put into the collections if they knew how much was required
- 35. Deliver bulletins to non-church goers
- 36. Be kept up to date about improvements in the hall and grounds outside which are dangerous to walk on
- Mail drop to householders in the area to cascade information and awareness
- Noticeboard at St Margaret's with mass times, etc.

## Liturgy / Opportunities for Prayer

- 39. Youth mass maybe monthly?
- 40. Parish day retreats / overnight

- 41. More rosary in months of May and October
- 42. Parish retreats
- 43. Encourage the parishioners to participate in the services
- 44. Day retreats
- 45. Praying
- 46. Good singing
- 47. No chattering

## Getting More People Involved

- More people encouraged to join and support groups
- 49. Recruit new volunteers best approach might be to ask people directly to become involved with a certain group or task
- 50. Encourage more people in the parish to take a more active role
- 51. More volunteers / members for St Vincent de Paul, UCM, etc.
- 52. Register kept at the back of church for people to sign up to voluntary events / groups
- 53. The women run most functions to improve finances - encourage others to support us
- 54. More helpers would be an advantage
- 55. Parishioners encouraged to volunteer (in small things / ways)
  involvement encouraging ownership
- 56. Might be helpful for representatives of groups to give an insight to what's involved to encourage participation from other parishioners (for consideration for next event?)
- 57. Encourage and support young people to get more involved

#### **Trips and Outings**

- 58. Run trips to Lourdes and parish retreats
- 59. Parish bus runs
- 60. Parish outing Carfin?
- 61. Annual parish family outing and/or barbecue
- 62. More socials for the older community e.g. dances monthly
- 63. Have more social activities in the parish hall, dances for example which were always well attended
- 64. Parish summer trips
- 65. Parish bus runs

#### Home Visits

- Home visits by clergy to families that rarely make it to church – perhaps 2 visits per clergy per week
- 67. Have a committee who could visit the sick especially ones without close relatives
- 68. Parish priests to visit peoples' homes! What happened to that? Getting to know your parishioners
- 69. Parish visits by parishioners to those unable to go to church

## Clubs (sports)

- 70. Football team to involve men and young men
- 71. Maybe start a parish sports club for young people i.e. football, swimming or zoomba, etc. Make the community more fun!
- 72. Organise more clubs involving recreational activities, table tennis, football, etc.

#### Men

- 73. Maybe some of the younger men would offer to assist the older passkeepers who work so hard every week
- 74. In winter time could men of the parish spread salt outside the church to help easy walking?
- 75. Women of this parish are the workers who raise money yet if there is anything official in the hall they are left to remove furniture and sort tables, etc. – no men ever volunteer

#### Fundraising

76. More people signed up to gift aid

- 77. Fundraising

#### Adult Formation

- 79. Offer more adult formation e.g. along the lines of RCIA but for those who are already catholics

- 85. More use of the hall for private functions, kids parties, etc.
